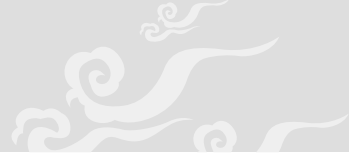

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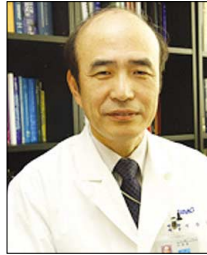


Invitation

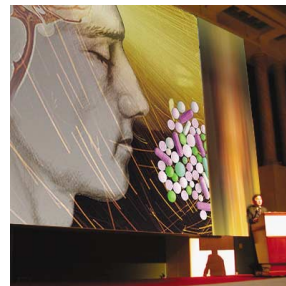
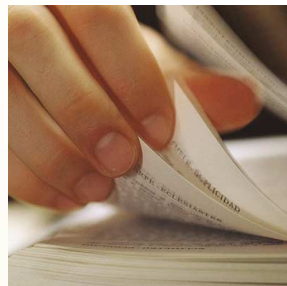

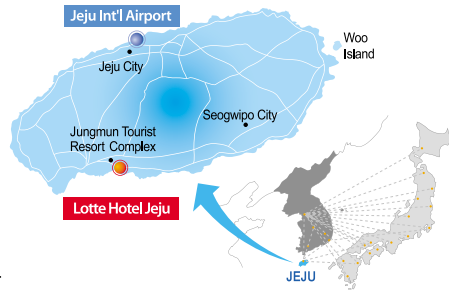

Welcome to Jeju

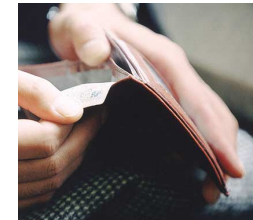
Interesting Information

Large and small tourist resorts and attractions dot the island. Whichever way you turn, you will be met by its natural scenery, the unique lifestyle of its inhabitants, and a traditional culture created by isolation from the main stream over two thousand years. Festivals held throughout the year provide excellent opportunities to gain insights into the character of the Island. Seasonal observances such as the Canola Flower Festival, Seashore Festival, Tamna Cultural Festival and Snow Blossom Festival are purveyors of local style and taste. Exploring Jeju's specialty foods is also absolutely to be recommended. Jeju's cuisine is characterized by its deference to nature and basic tastes. Throughout the year, there is fresh fish and seafood, organic meat from livestock that grazed in its clean mountains and prairies, juicy tangerines and exotic fruits.



Currency and Credit Card

Basic unit of Korean currency is Won(₩). The exchange rate changes with minor daily fluctuations. As of June 2006, 100 Yens equal approximately 840 Korean Won. Foreigner bank notes and traveler's check can be exchanged for Korean Won at the airport, hotels and Korean banks. Credit cards such as Visa, Master, JCB, American Express and Diners are all widely accepted.



Insurance and Emergency

The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for medical expenses in case of accidents or unexpected occurrences. Participants are advised to arrange their own insurance if it is needed. Emergency call numbers in Korea are 112 for police and 119 for fire/rescue and hospital service.



Business Hours

Government offices are open between 09:00 and 18:00 from Monday to Friday. Most private business opens at 09:00 and closes at 18:00. However, banks are exceptional. Their business hours are from 09:30 to 16:30 on weekdays only.



Electricity

In Korea, outlets for 220 volts are dominant. Always check the power supply before using your equipment.

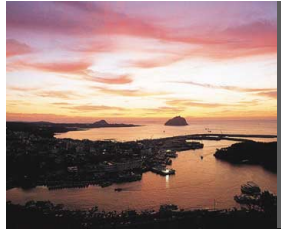
Korean Food

Korean cuisine provides unique aromas and tastes for visitors to savor. In addition to being highly nutritious, Korean food is also low calories. Visitors cannot really say they have been to Korea if they have not tasted "Kimchi", the internationally famous cabbage dish. More familiar to the foreign palate are "Bulgogi and bibimbab".



Climate

Climate of Jeju Island has the features of both subtropical oceanic climate and temperate climates, warm and mild, yet showing distinct seasonal changes. With an average temperature of 16°C (hottest summer-33.5°C, coldest January-1°C). There is big difference in the climate of Jeju City and Seogwipo city (located on opposite sides of Mt. Halla). Jeju Island possesses the mildest temperature fluctuations in Korea. The average temperature of Jeju Island in November is 10°C.

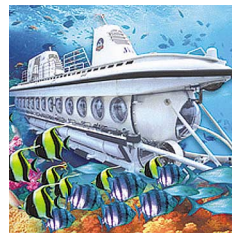

Marado Island

Marado Island is the starting point and the ending point of Korea. On the island stands a monument that notifies that it is southern tip of Korea. At the edge of the island, there are precipices, rock formations, a tunnel named "Namdaemun", and caves formed by the erosion of the sea. You can take the Songak Cruise and visit the southern tip of Korea.



Yongmeori Beach

Yongmeori Beach is a place where Mt. Sanbongsan stretches into the ocean and it looks as if a dragon's head is going underwater. This area is made of Sa-am stacks, built up over millions of years. Wild rocks stacking up on one another along the seashore cliffs create majestic scenery.



Yeomiji Botanical Garden

Yeomiji is home to a total of 2000 species of rare plants and 1700 species of flowers and trees. There are also open gardens in Japanese, Italian, French and Korean styles. The Garden is 1,120m² and is described as one of the best botanical gardens in Asia.



Cheonjiyeon Water Falls

Cheonjiyeon meaning god's pond, derives its name from the legend that the seven fairies serving the King of Heaven came down to the pond by stairs of cloud and bathed in its clean water. Walk along the subtropical path towards the Cheonjiyeon Falls to hear the sound of waterfalls.



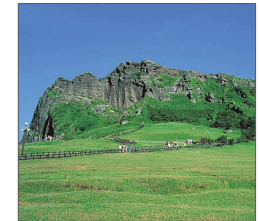
O'Sulloc Tea Museum

The museum is located among the plantations of green. Here you can see tea collecting methods and take pictures in the middle of tea plantations. The tea museum teaches you about Korean tea culture through a miniature of a green tea production line and many other interesting activities.



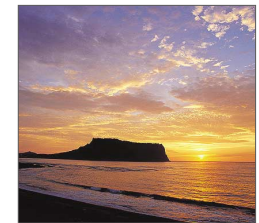
Udo Island

Udo Island is an island at the east end of Jeju Island. It is called Udo because its shape resembles that of a cow that is lying down or sticking out its head. Udo Island can give you the impression that you are seeing a miniaturized Jeju island when you see Jeju women divers, stone streets, stone tombs and very similar traditional culture and natural environments.



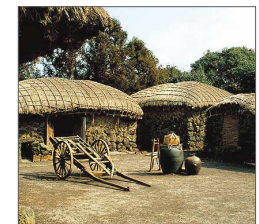
Seongsan Sunrise Peak

Seongsan Sunrise Peak rose from under the sea in a volcanic eruption about 100,000 years ago. Located on the eastern end of Jeju Island, there is a huge crater at the top of Seongsan Sunrise Peak. The sunrise from the crater is magnificent. Also the Seongsan Sunrise Peak between the bright yellow colored rapeseed flowers in the spring is a sight that must be seen.



Seongeup Folk Village

Located at the foot of Mt. Halla, Seongeup Folk Village has perfectly preserved Korean tradition. With its vast amount of cultural property, this place is designated as a Folk Village. Seongeup Folk Village shows the unique residential culture of the island. And these traditions, which cannot be seen elsewhere today, make the Folk Village a novel experience.
